ORDER FOR THE USE OF A MOBILE TRACKING DEVICE

TO: ALL AND SINGULAR SHERIFF'S AND/OR DEPUTY SHERIFF'S OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND/OR ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AUTHORIZED TO INVESTIGATE CRIMINAL OFFENSE:

WHEREAS, before me the Honorable Judge PETER A.D. MCGLAHAN in and for Volusia County, Florida, Seventh Judicial Circuit, a sworn and written Application for Mobile Tracking Device Authorization has been made on this date pursuant to Florida Statute 934.42, by FWC Officer Jeffrey R. Gier, a sworn officer of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, requesting authorization to place upon the vehicle, for the surreptitious use, removal and installation of a mobile tracking device upon the property described as: (Description of vehicle; registrant's name and address)

Both vehicles are at 509 Desoto Ave., De Leon Springs, FL and are both being used in an ongoing criminal enterprise.

AND WHEREAS, a tracking device is an electronic or mechanical device which permits the tracking of the movement of a vehicle or object to which it is attached.

AND WHEREAS, a criminal investigation is being conducted by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and the information from the mobile tracking device will be relevant to the investigations of registrant for the offense of: Unlawful Hunting While Under a Game & Fish Compact Hunting Privilege Suspension/Revocation, FS 379.354 (17).


AND, the Court finds that FWC Officer Jeffrey R. Gier has certified the information likely to be obtained by the requested installation and use of a tracking device is relevant to the ongoing criminal investigation specified above which is being conducted by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.

AND, this Court finds the above-described property to be tracked is mobile and is may be necessary to track said vehicle outside the jurisdiction of this court.

AND, this Order and the Application for it shall be safely kept by the Affiant, FWC Officer Jeffrey R. Gier until further order of a Court of competent jurisdiction.

NOW THEREFORE, you or either of you, with lawful assistance as may be necessary are hereby authorized in the surreptitious installation on the property described above and the use of a mobile tracking device within and outside the jurisdiction of this Court, but within the State of Florida, so long as the device is actually installed, as described above, while still within the jurisdiction of this Court for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days unless an Extension Order is issued. The mobile tracking device may be removed and re-installed during said time period as needed for maintenance, battery replacement, or other services
